# **Salcon (8567)**

### **Falling Wedge Pattern Breakout**



### **Technical Highlights**

The stock has been in a steady uptrend since late 2023, and throughout this period, it has formed a falling wedge pattern. Last week, the stock broke out of this wedge with volume, indicating a potential shift in momentum. Interestingly, this isn't the first time the stock has displayed this pattern before breaking out in an uptrend. Currently, it is challenging both the 50 and 200-day EMAs, while maintaining its position above the 20-day EMA.

Momentum indicators further support the bullish outlook. Buying volume has been increasing, and the RSI is currently at 50, rising sharply. Additionally, the MACD has formed a golden cross after staying neutral since August 2024.

The ideal entry point would be on a pullback, targeting a range between RM0.305 and RM0.315. If the breakout holds, the stock is likely to test its first resistance at RM0.360. A successful break above this could push the stock toward the next resistance at RM0.425, bringing it closer to its 52-week high. Conversely, if the stock falls to RM0.275, it may indicate a false breakout, potentially leading to a correction.

Entry – RM0.305 – RM0.315 Stop Loss – RM0.275 Target Price – RM0.360 – RM0.425

# **Hup Seng (5024)**

## **Targeting 52-Week High**



### **Technical Highlights**

The stock has been on an upward trajectory since early 2024, reaching a 52-week high before pulling back to form a macro W pattern. During this consolidation phase, it traded between a key resistance and support level. Last week, the stock broke out of the W pattern, and it's now trading above all three key EMAs, reinforcing both short-and long-term bullish momentum.

Momentum indicators are flashing green. The RSI currently stands at 70, a strong level that remains favourable as long as there are no sharp pullbacks. Additionally, the MACD is showing strength, having formed a golden cross in early October and continuing its upward path, signalling rising buying pressure and sustained momentum.

The ideal entry range is between RM1.18 and RM1.21. Once the stock tests its first resistance at RM1.26, it could push toward its 52-week high of RM1.33 if the bullish momentum holds. On the downside, a drop below RM1.13 would invalidate the W pattern and start triggering a correction phase.

Entry – RM1.18 – RM1.21 Stop Loss – RM1.13 Target Price – RM1.26 – RM1.33

#### Glossary of commonly used technical terms

Exponential Moving Average (EMA)

An indicator frequently used in technical analysis showing the average value of a security's price over a set period with greater weightage placed on the most recent data points.

Moving Average Convergence Divergence (MACD)

A trend-following momentum indicator that shows the relationship between two moving averages of prices. The MACD is calculated by subtracting the 26-day exponential moving average (EMA) from the 12-day EMA. A 9-day EMA of the MACD, called the "signal line", is then plotted on top of the MACD, functioning as a trigger for buy and sell signals.

Stochastic

A technical momentum indicator that compares a security's closing price to its price range over a given time period. The indicator's sensitivity to market movements can be reduced by adjusting the time period or by taking a moving average of the result.

Average True Range (ATR)

A measure of volatility whereby the indicator is the greatest of the following:

- current high less the current low;
- the absolute value of the current high less the previous close;
- the absolute value of the current low less the previous close:

**Bollinger Band** 

A band plotted 2 standard deviations away from a simple moving average.

On-Balance Volume (OBV)

A method used in technical analysis to detect momentum, the calculation of which relates volume to price change. OBV provides a running total of volume and shows whether this volume is flowing in or out of a given security.

The price level which, historically, a stock has had difficulty falling below. It is thought of as the level at which a lot of buyers tend to enter the stock.

Resistance

Support

The price at which a stock or market can trade, but not exceed, for a certain period of time. Often referred to as "resistance level".

Reversal

A change in the direction of a price trend. On a price chart, reversals undergo a recognisable change in the price structure. An uptrend, which is a series of higher highs and higher lows, reverses into a downtrend by changing to a series of lower highs and lower lows. A downtrend, which is a series of lower highs and lower lows, reverses into an uptrend by changing to a series of higher highs and higher lows.

Divergence

When the price of an asset and an indicator, index or other related asset move in opposite directions.

Overbought

In technical analysis, this term describes a situation in which the price of a security has risen to such a degree – usually on high volume – that an oscillator has reached its upper bound. This is generally interpreted as a sign that the price of the asset is becoming overvalued and may experience a pullback.

Oversold

A situation in technical analysis where the price of an asset has fallen to such a degree – usually on high volume – that the oscillator has reached a lower bound. This is generally interpreted as a sign that the price of the asset is becoming undervalued and may represent a buying opportunity for investors



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
