

# **Genetec Technology (0104)**

### Breakout Play, EMAs in sight



#### **Technical Highlights**

After reaching a recent peak at RM1.63, the stock pulled back and found a strong support at RM1.07. Since then, it has been forming a triangle pattern and just yesterday, the stock finally broke out of this squeeze zone with a strong buying candle, showing signs of renewed momentum. However, it is still trading below all 3 key EMAs. If buyers can continue to sustain this momentum, these EMAs levels will soon be tested.

Momentum indicators are starting to turn positive. The RSI has bounced back from oversold territory and is now sitting at 44. Meanwhile, the MACD is also on the verge of forming a golden cross.

For an ideal entry, the range to watch is RM1.19 to RM1.24. The first resistance level is RM1.36, and if the stock clears this, the next target will be RM1.49. On the downside, if the stock drops below RM1.07, it would indicate a false breakout and show the continuation of previous downtrend.

## **Key Breakout in Progress**



#### **Technical Highlights**

In just three months, the stock has touched both 52-week low at RM0.335 and a 52-week high at RM0.675. Currently, it is trading around the middle of this range at RM0.530, and remains in a downtrend. However, yesterday there was a surge in buying volume—the highest since January 2025—suggesting early signs of a potential breakout. If this momentum continues with the stock continuing to trade above the 200-day EMA, it could challenge its downtrend and transition into an upward movement.

Momentum indicators are looking good. The RSI has rebounded from oversold levels and now sits at 51. Meanwhile, the MACD is on the verge of forming a golden cross, which could confirm a bullish reversal if buying pressure continues.

An ideal entry range is RM0.515 to RM0.530. The first resistance level to watch is RM0.560, followed by RM0.605 if the breakout holds. On the downside, if the stock drops below RM0.475, it would indicate a failed breakout and keeping it within the downtrend.

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#### Glossary of commonly used technical terms

Exponential Moving Average (EMA)	An indicator frequently used in technical analysis showing the average value of a security's price over a set period with greater weightage placed on the most recent data points.
Moving Average Convergence Divergence (MACD)	A trend-following momentum indicator that shows the relationship between two moving averages of prices. The MACD is calculated by subtracting the 26-day exponential moving average (EMA) from the 12-day EMA. A 9-day EMA of the MACD, called the "signal line", is then plotted on top of the MACD, functioning as a trigger for buy and sell signals.
Stochastic	A technical momentum indicator that compares a security's closing price to its price range over a given time period. The indicator's sensitivity to market movements can be reduced by adjusting the time period or by taking a moving average of the result.
Average True Range (ATR)	A measure of volatility whereby the indicator is the greatest of the following: - current high less the current low; - the absolute value of the current high less the previous close; - the absolute value of the current low less the previous close;
Bollinger Band	A band plotted 2 standard deviations away from a simple moving average.
On-Balance Volume (OBV)	A method used in technical analysis to detect momentum, the calculation of which relates volume to price change. OBV provides a running total of volume and shows whether this volume is flowing in or out of a given security.
Support	The price level which, historically, a stock has had difficulty falling below. It is thought of as the level at which a lot of buyers tend to enter the stock.
Resistance	The price at which a stock or market can trade, but not exceed, for a certain period of time. Often referred to as "resistance level".
Reversal	A change in the direction of a price trend. On a price chart, reversals undergo a recognizable change in the price structure. An uptrend, which is a series of higher highs and higher lows, reverses into a downtrend by changing to a series of lower highs and lower lows. A downtrend, which is a series of lower highs and lower lows, reverses into an uptrend by changing to a series of higher highs and higher lows.
Divergence	When the price of an asset and an indicator, index or other related asset move in opposite directions.
Overbought	In technical analysis, this term describes a situation in which the price of a security has risen to such a degree – usually on high volume – that an oscillator has reached its upper bound. This is generally interpreted as a sign that the price of the asset is becoming overvalued and may experience a pullback.
Oversold	A situation in technical analysis where the price of an asset has fallen to such a degree – usually on high volume – that the oscillator has reached a lower bound. This is generally interpreted as a sign that the price of the asset is becoming undervalued and may represent a buying opportunity for investors



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
